Helping us to keep you safe

Dear Friends,

We are making extensive plans for church to recommence services on Thursday 1st April 2021, Maundy Thursday at 7pm. This will be followed by 2nd April Good Friday at 2pm and Easter Sunday on the 4th April at 10am.

In order that we can keep you safe we would ask you to help us in complying with Government Legislation.

- All services will require you to book a seat. This can be done by using our online booking service either through St John's church office or application to the Churchwardens or Secretary. If you know of anyone struggling with this, could you offer to help? Seating will be controlled at every service.
- Doors around the church will open to allow for ventilation. Please be prepared and well wrapped up
- A oneway system is in place, entry through the south west door and exit through the south east door
- You will need to comply with social distancing requirements. This means that you should take your seat on entry and avoid walking around the building

- At the end of the service please leave the building as soon as you are able through the south east door. There should be no congregating in the grounds after the service
- In complying with Covid 19 regulations we will be abiding with the 48 hour rule wherever possible The only known exception to this will be between the services on Maundy Thursday and Good Friday. On this occasion we will take the precaution of fogging all of the areas in the Church, flat surfaces, door handles with an antiviral disinfectant

We are aware that these requirements may seem onerous at the moment, but we would ask you to bear with us and we will all look forward to better times with fewer restrictions. We ask that you should help us to keep you safe.
